» Reimbursement Pre-Approval Request

- Required to submit to DEMA prior to any training, exercise or conference related costs not specifically identified and approved in an Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) grant application.
- » Work with your County EM & Region to leverage funding

Hosting In-State Training

- » Training Event Request Form
 - Must be signed by either the County or Tribal Emergency Manager for the jurisdiction
- » Minimum of 60 90 days notice to coordinate
- » Minimum & Maximum Student Enrollment Requirements
 - Varies by training program
- » Acadis <u>dematraining.az.gov</u>
- » AZ POST Continuing Training Credit
 - AZ POST has authorized DEMA to provide



Out-of-State Training

- » Reimbursement Pre-Approval Request
- » Classes fill quickly
 - Register a minimum of 120 days prior to event
- » Each provider has their own registration requirements
- » FEMA Student Identification Number (FEMA SID)
- » EMI's General Admissions Application
- » Most NDPC applications are now online
- » Applications must be complete including all signatures
- » Please no handwritten applications



 - Three year schedule
 - Best practices, capability gaps, key priorities, budget

» Coordinate Regionally


- Work through your County/Tribal Emergency Manager
