GRANT FUNDING GUIDELINES EAST REGION

Funding

- All projects must demonstrate a terrorism nexus
- Grant funding requests are diverse and as a result need to be focused on regional needs
- Projects that are in excess of \$200,000 should to be separated into multi-year phased projects, with a clear indication of what the specific needs are for each phase and priorities are clearly listed in your application
- Needs assessments should be completed prior to application of funds where applicable

Regionalism

- Projects should be multi-discipline and multi-agency in their scope to address regional issues

Sustainability

- Sustainability needs to be better addressed and executed to ensure that these projects maintain their viability
- Replacement costs for communications equipment that was originally funded by the SHSGP grant should be borne by the requesting agency. If the RAC recommends SHSGP funds, there may be additional information required (i.e. letter of commitment) identifying the commitment by the jurisdiction to sustain in whole or in part the project moving forward
- Applicants are encouraged to apply for projects that can close gaps identified in the Stakeholder Preparedness Review (SPR) regardless of whether previous funding has been received for same/similar projects
