**GRANT FUNDING GUIDELINES
NORTH REGION**

Interoperability/Information Sharing System

- Priority will be given to infrastructure projects that support a communications plan.
- Communications equipment requests must demonstrate support of regional interoperability.
 - Regional interoperability being defined as the ability to communicate across regional boundaries.

Regional Response Capabilities (SWAT, RRT, HAZMAT, EOD, IMT, Citizen Corps, Training & Exercise etc.)

- Priority may be given to projects that support a regional response capability.
- Encourage a project that will complete resource mapping/typing and response range for the North Region.

Sustainability

- Individualized asset may be supported by the local jurisdiction, however on-going costs related to regional assets may be supported by SHSGP funds.
- Priority may be given to projects that plan to assume sustainability costs at the jurisdictional level.
- Sustainability costs associated with interoperability may be supported.
- Associated costs to support Level A TLO may need to be supported by the local jurisdiction.
- Associated costs to support Level B and C TLO may be supported through SHSGP funds.

General

- Encourage projects that will promote public emergency information outreach and communications efforts.
